**SCHOOL CONTEST**  
**PSEG Long Island Energy Kit Program School Contest**  
**“Official Rules”**

*No entry fee or purchase necessary to enter or win this PSEG Long Island Energy Efficient Kit Program School Contest (“School Contest”).*

*The 2019-2020 School Contest entry period begins on July 1, 2019 and ends on December 15, 2019. Winners will be announced in January of 2020. Prizes will be awarded in January of 2020. This School Contest is subject to all applicable laws and regulations. Void where prohibited by law. The sponsor of this School Contest is The National Theatre for Children, Inc. (“Sponsor” or “NTC”).*

*By entering and participating in the School Contest, participant (“Entrant”): (1) fully and unconditionally agrees to accept and be bound by these “Official Rules” and by all decisions of Sponsor, which include, without limitation, decisions regarding eligibility, winners and the interpretation of the terms used in these Official Rules, which shall be final and binding in all respects; and (2) represents and warrants that all information provided by Entrant in connection with the School Contest is true, accurate and complete as of the date of entry.*

**1. OBJECTIVE:** NTC is asking schools in PSEG Long Island Service area in New York to sign up participants in the PSEG Long Island Energy Kit Program. As part of an energy literacy curriculum, NTC is delivering live, interactive performances and sending students home with Energy Efficient Kit requests. This School Contest awards the three elementary schools and the three middle schools with the highest number of sign-ups (eligible and ineligible Kits) one of three monetary prizes. The school with the greatest number of kit sign-ups will receive \$1,000, the school with the second greatest number of kit sign-ups will receive \$750, and the school with the third greatest number of kit sign-ups will receive \$500.

**2. ELIGIBILITY:**

**a.** This School Contest is open to any school in the PSEG Long Island Service area in the state of New York (including private or public institutions), who are participating in the National Theatre for Children PSEG Long Island Energy Program.

**b.** All entrants must meet the following criteria:

- i.** Must be participating members of The National Theatre for Children PSEG Long Island Energy Program.

- ii. Must fill out all proper registration paperwork provided by PSEG Long Island for Energy Efficient Kit requests. These requests may be submitted through a paper submission, phone call, or online at PSEGenegykit.org.
- iii. Valid registration for sign-ups must be on file with NTC by the end of the School Contest on December 15, 2019.

### **3. HOW TO ENTER:**

**a. Submit Sign-ups.** Submit all sign-ups to NTC by December 15, 2019 for the 2019-2020 School Contest period.

**4. ENTRY GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS:** No entry fee or purchase necessary. Possession of an entry does not constitute valid proof of delivery or receipt. Any attempt to enter the School Contest in a manner other than as permitted in this **Section 3** shall be VOID and subject Entrant to disqualification from further participation in the School Contest. Entries received from persons not meeting eligibility requirements will be disqualified. Sponsor shall not be liable for late, incomplete, or inaccurate entry forms or sign-up submissions, or for technical, hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connection, or failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed computer transmissions, telephone connections, or any human error which may occur in the receipt of the entries in this School Contest.

**5. SUBMISSION DEADLINE:** The submission deadline will be strictly enforced. Entry forms and/or sign-up submissions will not be accepted beyond December 15, 2019 for the 2019-2020 School Contest period.

### **6. WINNER(S):**

**a.** The winning school(s) will be announced after December 15, 2019 for the 2019-2020 School Contest period. Sponsor's website is located @ [www.nationaltheatre.com](http://www.nationaltheatre.com). Upon confirmation of eligibility, prizes will be awarded within thirty (30) days. Sponsor shall pay for all shipping and handling costs associated with the distribution of prizes. Prizes are guaranteed to be awarded in accordance with these rules.

**b.** The winning school(s) may be required to sign an Affidavit of Eligibility/Release of Liability/Prize Acceptance Form upon being notified as a winner. Noncompliance may result in disqualification and an alternate winner(s) may be selected.

### **6. PRIZES:**

**a.** The three elementary schools and the three middle schools with the highest number of sign-ups will win one of three monetary prizes of \$1,000.00, \$750.00 or \$500.00. Prizes will be paid by check. The odds of winning are dependent on the number of valid submissions. The total prize amount, awarded in this School Contest is approximately \$2,750. All prizes will be awarded in connection with the School Contest.

**b.** Within thirty (30) days of the announcement of the winner(s), Sponsor will provide winner(s) with the prize, or a voucher, certificate or other document giving winner(s) unconditional right to receive the prize. All prizes are non-transferable and non-endorsable and non-cash prizes cannot be redeemed for cash. All costs, fees, expenses and taxes (including without limitation federal, state, and local taxes) associated with any element of any prize not explicitly stated herein as being provided (and the reporting consequences thereof) are the sole and exclusive responsibility of the winner(s). All income taxes associated with the acceptance of a prize are the sole responsibility of the winner(s).

**7. DISQUALIFICATION/INELIGIBILITY:** Without limiting any other provision of these Official Rules, the Sponsor reserves the right, any time and in their sole discretion, to disqualify and/or deem a participant ineligible to participate in this School Contest. Furthermore, the Sponsor reserve the right, in their sole and absolute discretion, to disregard and/or deem VOID such Entrant's entry in the School Contest.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY:** By participating, Entrant agrees to release Sponsor, its agents, representatives, affiliates and employees from and against any and all liability for any injuries, losses, and/or damages caused by or resulting from entry or participating in the School Contest, or resulting from the acceptance, possession or use of the prize(s). The Sponsor is not responsible for any expenses incurred by Entrant in connection with participation in the School Contest.

**11. MODIFICATION/TERMINATION OF OFFICIAL RULES:** Sponsor further reserves the right to modify any terms of the School Contest at any time at Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor further reserves the right to terminate the School Contest at any time at Sponsor's sole discretion. The Sponsor shall assume no responsibility for cancellation due to labor strike industry conditions, commercial viability, or any other cause beyond Sponsor's reasonable control.

**12. PUBLICITY:** By participating, Entrant:

**a.** Grants Sponsor permission to use Entrant's submission in the promotion of the School Contest and any future contest(s);

**b.** Agrees to cooperate with Sponsor's media partners in any promotional materials and/or advertising of the School Contest, including use of Entrant's name and school information in any promotional materials and/or advertising of the School Contest, except where prohibited by law; and

**c.** Agrees to participate in any follow up surveys conducted by Sponsor or any of its affiliates.

**13. LAW:** The School Contest shall be conducted in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota. All disputes concerning these terms and the School Contest shall be adjudicated in the federal or state courts having jurisdiction over Hennepin County, Minneapolis, Minnesota USA.
